OUR COURSES

MA Filmmaking

An intensive two-year course that trains students to a professional level in a full range of filmmaking skills. Students leave with a portfolio of producing, directing, editing, cinematography, production design and sound credits.

Drop in sessions will be taking place during the afternoon and evening.

MA Screenwriting

An intensive one-year programme that develops the writer's original voice, embeds professional practice and enhances employability.

Drop in sessions will be taking place during the afternoon and evening.

The MA Screenwriting team will be based in room P306.



MA Film Marketing

The one-year MA Film Marketing programme introduces students to all aspects of B2B and B2C marketing strategies for the film industry - from key art design and promotional trailers to media, publicity and social media plans.

Drop in sessions will be taking place during the afternoon.

MA Film Producing

This one-year course addresses all the core competences required of a professional film producer in an industry which operates globally.

MA International Film Business

This one year course provides invaluable insight into the world of international film business and includes a trip to a major global film festival.

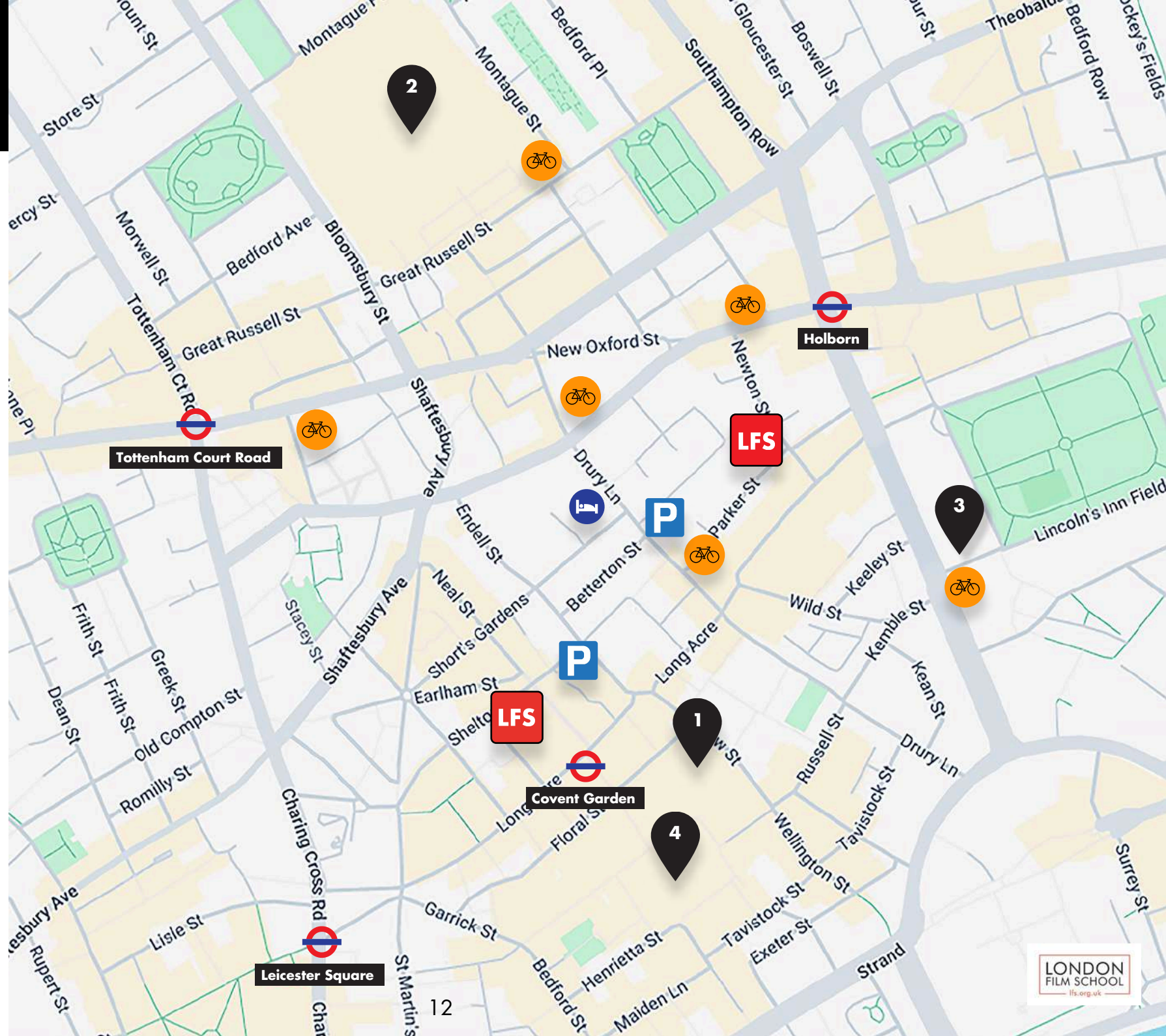

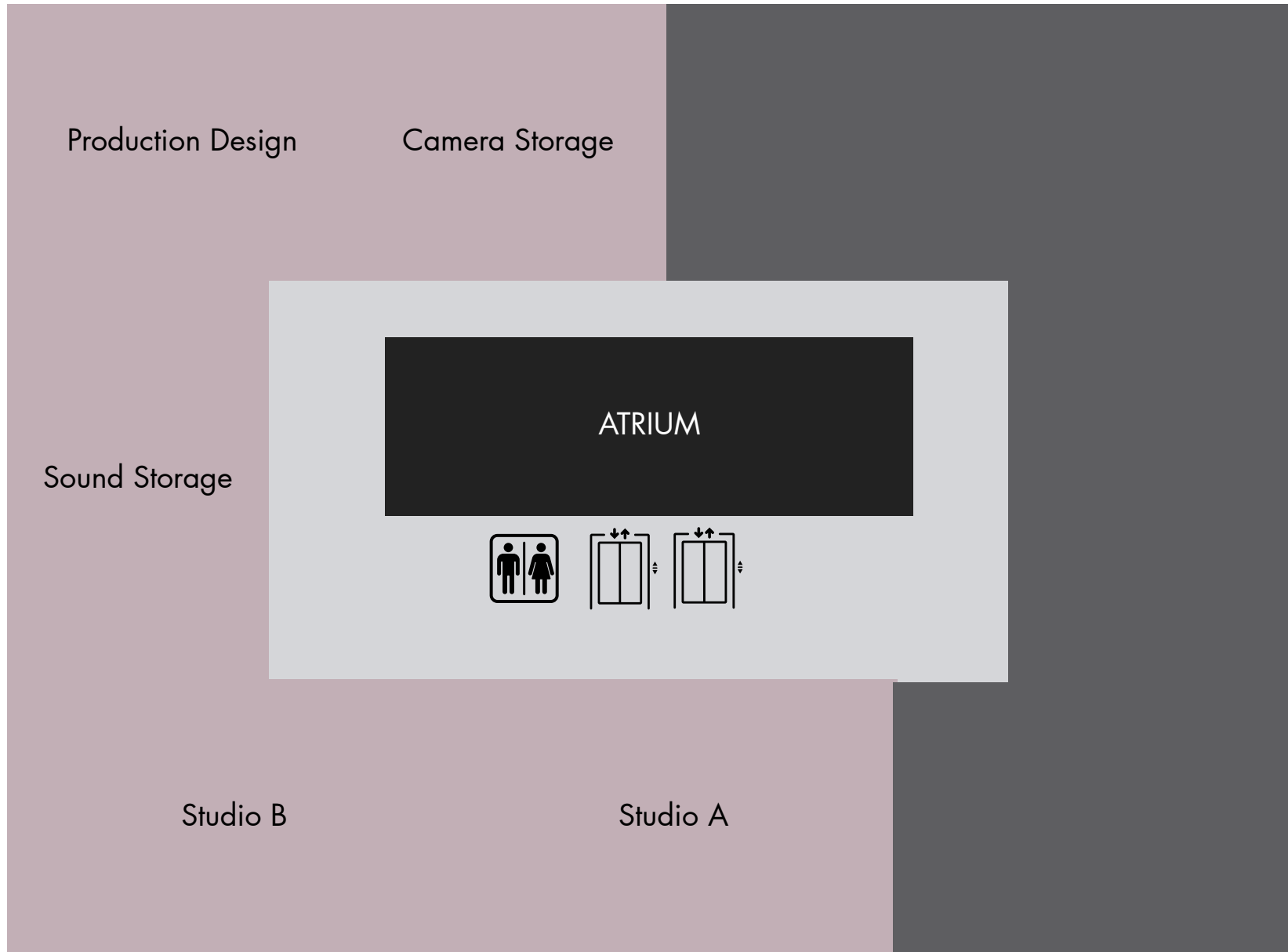

First Floor - Parker Street

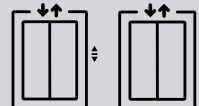


Second Floor - Parker Street

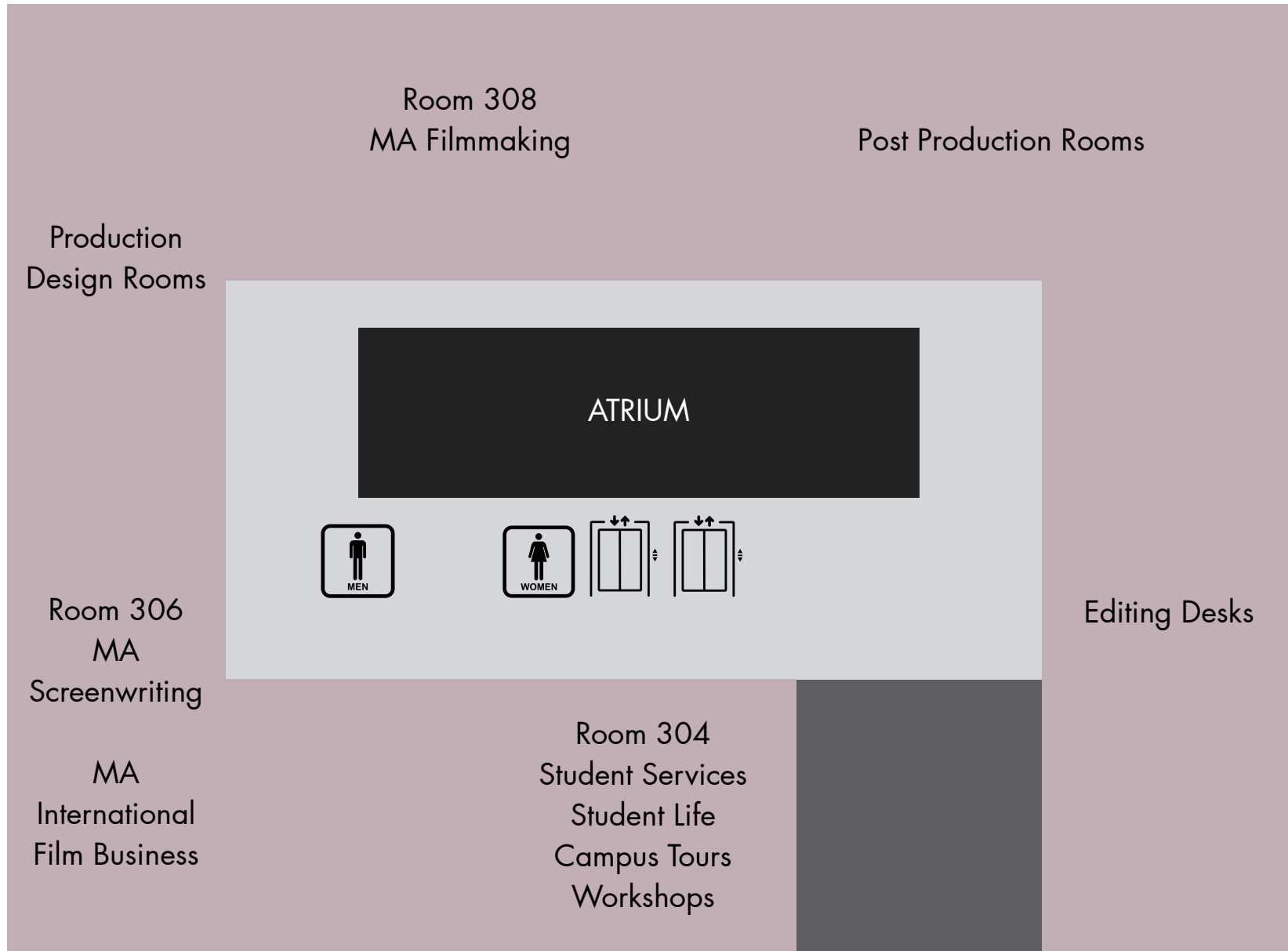

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the venue for the Open Day?

The address is London Film School, 39 - 41 Parker Street, London, WC2B 5PQ.

What are the closest tube stations?

LFS is within a 10-15 minute walk from the following tube stations:

- Holborn (Central Line & Piccadilly Line)
- Covent Garden (Piccadilly Line)
- Leicester Square (Piccadilly Line & Northern Line)
- Tottenham Court Road (Central Line, Northern Line & Elizabeth Line)

What are the closest train stations for mainline connections?

The following train stations are close but we would recommend using the tube, bus or taxi to reach the school.

- Euston
- Kings Cross St. Pancras
- Waterloo
- Charing Cross

What are the closest bus routes?

The closest bus stops are:

High Holborn Stop Q - Routes 8 and 98

Holborn Station Stop P - Routes 59, 188 and 243

Holborn Station Stop N - Routes 1, 68 and 91

What happens when I arrive at the school?

A team of student ambassadors will be waiting to welcome you to the Open Day. They will sign you in and help with directing you to your first activity whether that's a talk, tour, or one of the drop in sessions.

What can I expect at the Open Day?

Representatives from five of our courses, our student services team, our short courses team and our student ambassadors are available during the day. Each course will also be giving a presentation which introduces the course and provides an overview. Please see our schedule for timings and locations. Feel free to pop in to the drop in sessions and ask them any questions you have about London Film School.

Will I be allowed to walk around the Campus?

You will be able to visit the Parker Street and Shelton Street buildings via the Campus Tours. The meeting point for tours is P304.

What if I need help on the day?


Please do reach out to a member of staff or a student ambassador if you are lost or have any questions.
